They are in constant use by students and staff, and despite the temperature and humidity, have performed as well or better than our metal alternatives here in Cambridge. The mechanisms are very well engineered and the finish work is of the highest professional quality. We would have expected to pay a much higher price for both the cabinets and the shipping from the USA and so we were able to use the savings to buy an additional cabinet and fill the drawers with your unit trays.

I would very enthusiastically recommend your cabinets and drawers to any natural history collection anywhere in the world. They are first rate, were delivered with weeks of ordering and are very reasonably priced. We will be ordering more in the next year or so.
